**DENTAL RELEASE FORM**

Your pet is scheduled for a dental cleaning, scaling and polishing today. This procedure is performed under anesthesia. Like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Before administering anesthesia, the doctor will perform a full physical examination. Pre-anesthetic blood work maximizes your pets' safety and allows the doctors to detect any diseases that might complicate this procedure such as dehydration, anemia, infection, diabetes and/or liver disease. These tests are similar to those your own physician would run if you were to undergo anesthesia. They also establish a baseline of values, which are useful for diagnostics and treatments should your pet become sick in the future.

Factors that limit our ability to detect every dental problem your pet may have include:

- Lack of patient cooperation to allow proper visualization, especially the back teeth
- Many periodontal problems can be detected only probing under the gum
- Dental tartar can hide underlying cavities or fractures
- Some problems can be detected only with x-rays(\$25.00 per view)
